Spin-the-Wheel (or Roll Dice) Questions

The questions on this page are examples of the kinds of questions you can ask players. Feel free to choose the questions you're most comfortable with or to make up questions of your own.

Whatever gets the conversation about Jesus started.

1) Is Jesus the Son of God or was He just a carpenter?

Jesus is the Son of God. He was a carpenter by trade, but He is actually God in the flesh. He's fully God and fully human. God sent His Son, Jesus, to Earth in a human body to die on the cross for our sins. Whoever believes in Jesus will live with God for eternity.

2) Will God forgive your sins because you're a "good person" or because you have believed that His Son, Jesus, paid for your sins on the cross?

Not one of us is a good person. We are all sinners in need of Jesus to make us clean. God forgives anyone who believes Jesus alone, God in the flesh, paid for our sins on the cross. We do good deeds because of what Jesus has done for us, but good deeds can't pay for sin.

3) Does being kind get you to Heaven or do you get to Heaven by believing Jesus died on the cross to pay for you sins?

God receives anyone into Heaven who believes that Jesus alone, the Son of God, died on the cross for our sins. Kindness is good, but being kind cannot pay for sin and make you fit to live in Heaven with God. Only faith in Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection saves from sin.

4) Did God send His son, Jesus, to Earth because He loved us and wanted to save us from sin or because He wanted to punish us?

God so loved the world that He sent His only Son, Jesus, down to Earth to die on the cross for our sins. Whoever trusts in Jesus alone to pay for our sin and make us fit for Heaven will not be condemned but have eternal life.

5) Are Jesus and Satan equal in power or did Jesus create Satan?

Jesus created all things, including the angels. He created Satan as a beautiful angel. Satan became a fallen angel when he disobeyed God. Jesus is infinitely more powerful than Satan. For the time being, God has given Satan authority over Earth to test humans, but Jesus will cast Satan into the Lake of Fire (Hell) at the end of the world.

6) Did Peter deny Jesus three times, or did he say that Jesus is the Son of God? Clue: Trick question. Answer: Both. Peter declared Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. He also denied Jesus three times. Jesus still died for Peter on the cross, and Peter went on to do mighty things for Jesus. Jesus died for all sinners on the cross. Whoever trusts in Jesus receives full forgiveness of sins and will live with God for eternity.

Prizes - Please have each game participant pick a prize from the bin. Prizes are organized by age: **KIDS 5-12** / **13+** / **KIDS UNDER 5 get a prize even if they don't play.**

Bibles - Please ask each player if he or she has a Bible of his own. If he doesn't, or if all he has is an online Bible or a Bible at a relative's house (or something like that), then please give him a Bible.
